Second, you will design a necktie that represents your book on a posterboard necktie. Neat and colorful illustrations should decorate the entire necktie. So, make your pictures large enough to fill your space. Also, outline your pictures in sharpie or dark colors so that they "pop." In a creative way, display the title and author of your book on the tie front.


Third, type an explanation of your tie design on a separate sheet of paper. What does it
